ABOUT THE AREA

The Makgadikgadi Pans span 16,000 square kilometres (9,942 square miles) and are amongst the largest salt pans in the world. Remnants of an ancient lake, the pans are interspersed with sandy desert and occasional vegetation. One of Africa's biggest zebra populations makes this vista of white sand and salt their home. When rains fall during the wet season, the pans are filled with water and attract large flocks of flamingos, as well as big herds of zebra, springbok and wildebeest, followed closely by predators, making for fantastic game viewing.

ACCOMMODATION

Jack's Camp is one of the most iconic and celebrated camps in all of Africa. Situated on the edge of a vast salt pan, the remnants of a prehistoric super lake, the camp's striking, otherworldly setting invokes the savage beauty of a long-forgotten Africa. A visit here may be as close as you'll ever get to feeling that you're on a different planet. There are plenty of activities such as meeting habituated meerkats, walking in the wild with a group of San Bushmen, game drives, horse riding and quad biking across the pans.

The camp consists of 10 luxurious and stylish old-world tents, complete with bhukara-muslin draped walls, Persian rugs, and vintage lithographs. Other facilities include a private museum, a swimming pool pavilion and a marvellously decadent tea tent. There's a range of desert-adapted species, such as lion, cheetah, oryx, aardwolf, brown hyena, elephant, zebra, wildebeest and, during the green season of November through to mid-May, Africa's second largest zebra migration.

ACCOMMODATION

Duba Plains Camp is situated in northern Botswana on the 77,000-hectare Duba Plains Reserve at the heart of the Okavango Delta. A matrix of palm-dotted islands, floodplains and woodlands, the private reserve is typical of the region's unique landscape. The camp allows for game drives as well as boat-based activities through the delta's channels.

Duba Plains Camp offers five bespoke tents. All the rooms are raised on recycled railway sleeper decking and offer guests amazing views of the surrounding floodplain and a steady stream of wildlife parading past. Each tent has a lounge area, as well as the opportunity for private dining in your tent. Each guest tent offers a private verandah and pool, plus beautifully appointed ensuite facilities. The main area has a dining room, lounge, wine cellar and library. Wildlife to be spotted ranges from lions and leopards to elephants and buffaloes, and everything in between. Duba Plains is also known for interesting Kalahari species like Aardwolf and Pangolin.

90-Minute Doors Off Scenic Helicopter Flight of Okavango Delta

You will enjoy a unique aerial perspective of the seasonal floodplains, continuing over permanent waterways and finally to the meandering Okavango River in northwest Botswana, viewing the entire stretch of the 1,000th World Heritage Site. Your private scenic flight is designed to find as many iconic animals as this ancient landscape allows, set against a backdrop of incredible sweeping vistas of the full Okavango Delta, responsible for breathing life into this part of Africa.

Heading north-west from camp towards Namibia and Angola, where the water originates, you will be taken on a journey over every type of wilderness the delta has to offer. Lush savannah, towering palm tree filled islands surrounded by bumbling hippos and crocodile infested channels lined with white sandy banks that feed into vast lagoons that support large herds of elephants and elusive predators adept at navigating this extensive wetland.

During the scenic flight, you can assist the pilot in choosing the perfect spot to land on your very own private island, where you will be able to take in a ground-level view of this remote region of the Okavango. Enjoy a refreshing drink and sumptuous picnic while absorbing the sounds and smells of this magnificent wilderness. The second half of your flight will follow vast waterways on the opposite side of Chief's Island, offering the opportunity to explore more unique landscapes and a different selection of wildlife.

ACCOMMODATION

Much of the Okavango Delta has more water than land, but Mombo stands on the largest land mass in this wetland – fittingly called Chief's Island – so there's plenty of dry land for the soil to work with the water and sun to create a fertile ecosystem. The diversity of plant life in the Mombo concession, which is incidentally known as the Place of Plenty, within the Moremi Game Reserve creates a mix of habitats savannah, woodland and floodplain. With such an abundance of game, drives are the principal activity at Mombo.

Newly rebuilt, the nine luxury tented villas at Mombo are spacious with plenty of capacity for relaxation. There's a pool deck which makes an ideal space in which to cool off during the heat of the day.

The productive habitat of Mombo offers arguably the best big game viewing in Africa. Spectacular numbers of plains game which begin virtually on Mombo's decks - like zebra, red lechwe, impala, giraffe, warthog, wildebeest, kudu, elephant and buffalo - mean that predators are abundant, with especially high densities of lion, spotted hyena, wild dog and leopard.
